Dear Pupils, Parents & Guardians,

We are extremely proud of the fact that the majority of children from Glory Farm Primary School walk, cycle or scooter their journeys to and from school each day.

We have cycle parking for 80 bikes and scooter parking for 20 two-wheel scooters.

If your child would like to cycle or scooter to school please discuss the form overleaf with your child before signing and return it to school. Once we have received the slip, pupils will be issued with a unique numbered security label to identify their vehicle in the school grounds.

Pupils who do not keep to the terms of the Charter will have to return their security tag and will no longer be allowed to bring their scooter or bike to school.

We hope all parents and pupils will support our aim to ensure all pupils feel safe and secure on their school journey, regardless of how they travel. The first security label issued is free and any subsequent labels will be at a cost of £1.

Two Wheel Charter

We are keen to promote safe and secure cycling for all our pupils.
Our Two Wheel charter states that:

- 1) All pupils under 9 years old will be accompanied on their scooter or cycle journey to and from school by an adult
- 2) Pupils over 9 will let their parents/guardians know the route they are going to use

All pupils will

- **Wear a properly fitted helmet**
- **Wear clothes that are visible to all road users**
- **Be aware of pedestrians and other road users throughout their journey**
- **Use a safe cycle route to and from school**
- **Dismount outside all entrances to the school site and push their cycle/scooter to the parking areas**
- **Use the parking nearest to the school gate by which they enter the site**
- **Provide a lock to secure their bike/scooter and helmet in the park**
- **Be responsible for the security and roadworthiness of their bike/scooter**
- **Report any problems with their route to and from school to their parent/guardian and the school office.**

Please note: The school cannot accept any responsibility for the safety of cycles, scooters and helmets left in the park, or the safety of pupils, parents or guardians on the journey to and from school.

The terms of this Charter are subject to review and amendment annually.
